### Street Work Update


By now the street work has been completed in our community. There may be some areas that need touch-up and we will take care of those items. We want to thank everyone for their cooperation in this process. Thank you.

Before you perform any exterior changes to your home, you must first submit an architectural variance request application to the Board for review and approval. Changes made without association approval may not be permitted and will have to be changed. Please note that the association has completed the update of the approved color schemes. If you are planning on painting the exterior of your home, please call our manager for more details on the new color schemes.

#### View Issues

We want to remind you that the trees on your property may be blocking the view of your neighbor. The association's CC&R's do contain provisions to protect the view that some owners have due to the location of their properties. In most cases, our owners have worked well together to address this issue. Please take the time to inspect your tress and arrange for any necessary trimming.
