# **Exterior Changes**

Before you perform any exterior changes to your home, you must first submit an architectural variance request application to the Board for review and approval. Changes made without association approval may not be permitted and will have to be changed.

# **Exterior Painting**

If you have not painted the exterior of your home within the past few years, it may be time to consider some touch-up work or a complete repainting. Please take a moment to inspect the exterior of your home. If you need information on the approved paint colors or need a Home Improvement application, please call our management office.
