## Fall Maintenance Reminders

With Fall here, it is time to consider some basic maintenance items that can help protect your family and save you money. Some of the items to consider are:

- Change the batteries in your smoke detectors.

- Replace the filters for your heating system.
- Check the water supply lines for your appliances and plumbing fixture. (Use the steel braided hoses)
