Dwelling Live Notifications

Exterior Changes

Before you perform any exterior changes to your home, you must first submit an architectural variance request application to the Board for review and approval. Changes made without association approval may not be permitted and will have to be changed.

Time for Change

With the pending change in our time, it is now a good time to check the batteries in your smoke detectors, carbon monoxide detectors and emergency equipment such as flash lights and radios. It is also a good time to check the timing on your irrigation systems. You may also want to inspect items such as the water supply lines for your sinks, toilets, dishwasher, and clothes washer. If you have not already done so, it is a good idea to replace out original or older supply lines with the steel braided hoses. Your efforts will save you time and money!



Exterior Paint Colors

If you are thinking of repainting the exterior of your home, please remember that you must submit a Home Improvement application to the association for approval. Also, please remember that we have a large number of preapproved color schemes. To see the approved color schemes, please e-mail the manager with the request.

Iron Fence Maintenance

As a reminder, the iron fence around your home is yours to repair and maintain and when necessary, replace. The approved color for the iron fencing is Dunn Edwards Swiss Coffee. Please take some time to inspect your fence to determine if repairs are needed and if painting is needed. If you have not painted your fencing within the last two years, it is very likely that some repairs and painting is needed.
