Resident Vehicles

Coyote Concerns

Please be sure to keep your small pets inside at night or in a protected area. Also, please do not leave food out for your pets or for the wild animals as this will tend to attract the coyotes to your home.

Vehicle Security

We want to remind you of the past vehicle break-in that have occurred in our community as well as in the surrounding communities. Iron Fence Maintenance

As a reminder, the iron fence around your home is yours to repair and maintain and when necessary, replace. The approved color for the iron fencing is Dunn Edwards Swiss Coffee. Please take some time to inspect your fence to determine if repairs are needed and if painting is needed. If you have not painted your fencing within the last two years, it is very likely that some repairs and painting is needed.
